

Madisonville Community College Request for Academic Bankruptcy

Instructions

1. You may declare academic bankruptcy if you have not been enrolled in a Kentucky community college for the past **two** (2) or more years and have completed 12 or more semester hours in non-developmental courses with a 2.00 or better GPA.
2. Courses that were successfully completed with a grade of A,B,C,D or P prior to readmission will be counted as credit hours earned but not in the calculation of the GPA. The calculation of the GPA after the student declares academic bankruptcy
3. The academic bankruptcy option may be used only once.

I understand that coursework successfully completed prior to the bankruptcy will only count as hours earned and not in my cumulative grade point average.
