ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

All applicants are required to submit the information listed below to the MCC Admissions Office:

- skills assessment (placement) test (ACT or Compass)
- final high school transcript or GED scores
- official transcript(s) from any other college(s) attended. Please note: you must request that our Registrar's Office evaluate your transcript credit, in order to transfer any coursework to MCC.

Admission to MCC does not guarantee admission to specific academic programs. Consult the program coordinator for program admission information and admissions deadlines. See below for additional requirements.

NEW STUDENTS (applicants who have never attended another college or university as a degree-seeking student) are required to attend a **First Semester Experience** (FSE) orientation and advising session prior to fall or spring registration.

VISITING STUDENTS must submit a completed **Transient Student Form** or a **letter of good standing** from their home college, in addition to official transcripts from other colleges attended.

HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS, taking classes prior to their graduation, must submit their current high school transcript and the completed **Early Admission Form** in addition to the requirements listed above.

PLACEMENT INFORMATION

Placement exams are required of all incoming degree-seeking freshmen and like all public higher education institutions in Kentucky, MCC observes a mandatory placement policy. Test scores must be less than 5 years old and are required to be submitted prior to student registration. **ALL STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO TAKE THE COMPASS TEST UNLESS ACT SCORES EXEMPT THEM.** Students who do not meet minimum scores on any or all the ACT sections of English (minimum score of 18), reading (20), and/or math (19) will be required to take the Compass test for appropriate course placement. Students who do not submit test scores will be considered non-degree seeking and, as a result, will not be eligible for financial aid.

FINANCIAL AID & TUITION

All MCC students are encouraged to complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid), available online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. The FAFSA may be completed prior to submitting an application for admission or registering for classes. Please note: The priority deadline for **Fall 2014** financial aid is July 1, 2014; for **Spring 2014**, November 1, 2013. Students applying for or completing financial aid files after this date will encounter delays in processing.
